

# RAMP Up! Ridgway

Project Update: April 17, 2017

Town will be abuzz with construction activity the week of April 17 with ACC crews remobilizing and the SMPA moving in to remove power lines. Plus, the town will host the public meeting for the kick-off of the second season of the Ramp Up! Ridgway project.

**The San Miguel Power Association will be removing existing power lines and poles on SH 62 from Cora Street to Liddell on Tuesday, April 18 (Tax Day). This work will require a single lane closure with flaggers alternating the traffic flow and managing the intersections on the south side of the highway. SH 62 will also be closed intermittently as the lines are brought down. Stay alert.**

ACC, CDOT and the Town of Ridgway welcome you to a Public Meeting on Monday April 17, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in town hall. At this time, we will reintroduce the project team, provide a base timeline for the work ahead of us and provide an overview of the work activities and their impact on traffic. I hope you can join us.

ACC crews will begin mobilizing to Ridgway on Monday with work starting in earnest on Monday, April 24. As you know, when crews return our key responsibilities are to install the cross walks and cross pans in town, cross walks across SH 62, finish up the north lane on SH 62 including sidewalks, and of course, landscape and irrigation. This work is scheduled to take 44 working days. CDOT and ACC have been discussing a potential change order to add work which could potentially extend drainage and paving up SH 62 and extend our time in town. Please join us at the Public Meeting for more detail or look for next week's update.
