

**ORDINANCE NO. 08-06**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF RIDGWAY, COLORADO,  
PROVIDING INCENTIVES FOR THE USE OF SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to encourage the use of certain solar energy systems by creating a temporary incentive program without any change in Town taxes or tax policy,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIDGWAY, COLORADO, as follows:

**SECTION 1:**

The Ridgway Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new Subsection 6-1-12 to read as follows:

**6-1-12 SOLAR ENERGY INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

- (A) The Town will make a payment equal to the amount of Town sales tax paid by the customer and received by the Town, adjusted for any vendor's fee, for the purchase of systems which are installed within the Town, which will generate electricity or hot water from sunlight for domestic use, industrial processes, space heating, pools or spas.
- (B) Applications must be submitted on forms provided by the Town accompanied by proof of payment of Town sales tax and proper installation of the system acceptable to the Town.
- (C) This incentive shall terminate, as of every biennial anniversary of the effective date of this ordinance unless renewed by a motion to the Town Council at or about such time.

ADOPTED by the Ridgway Town Council on June 11, 2008.
