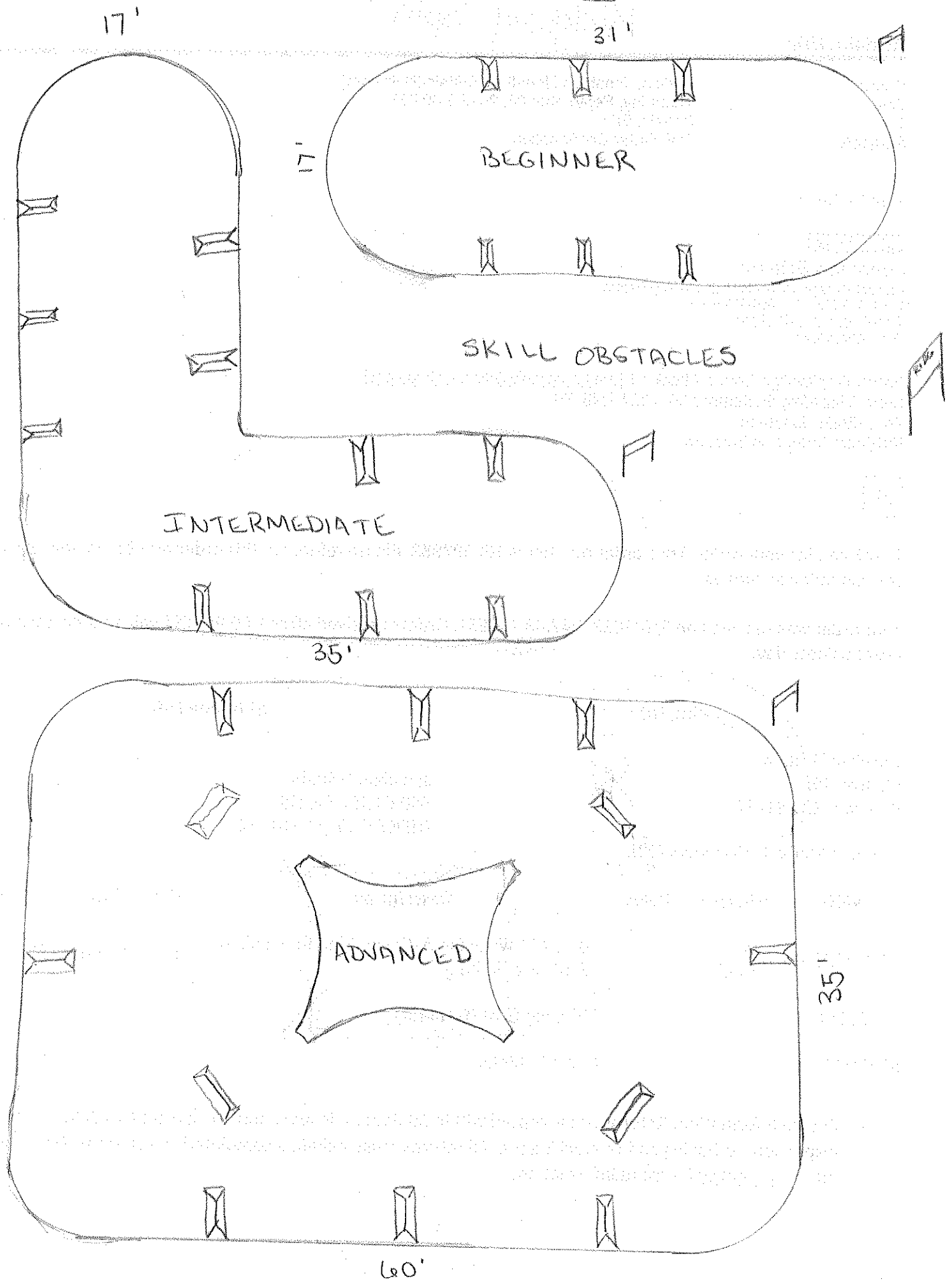

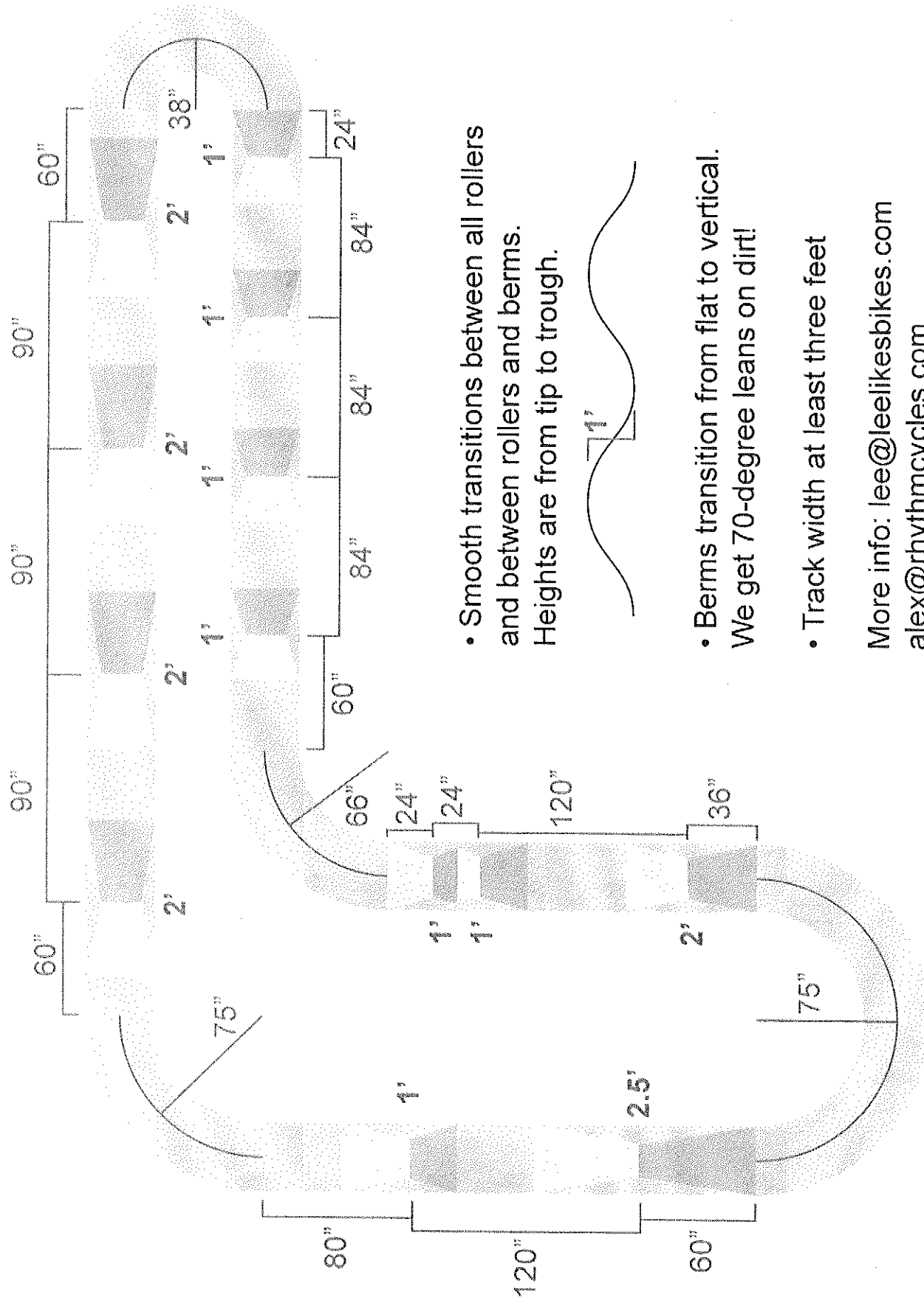

- Smooth transitions between all rollers and between rollers and berms. Heights are from tip to trough.



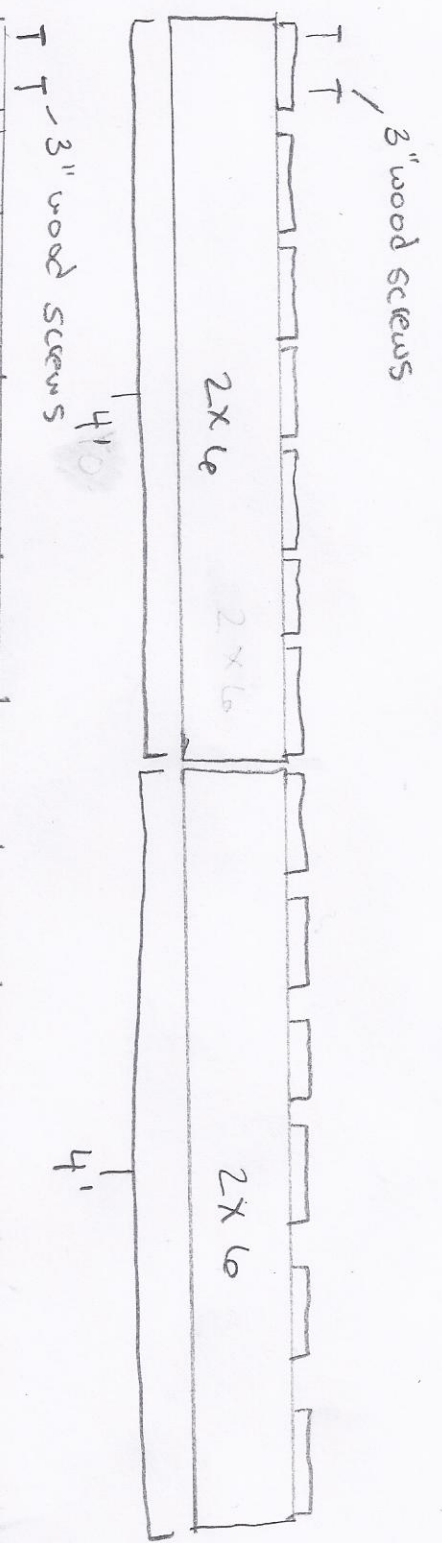
- Berms transition from flat to vertical. We get 70-degree leans on dirt!

- Track width at least three feet

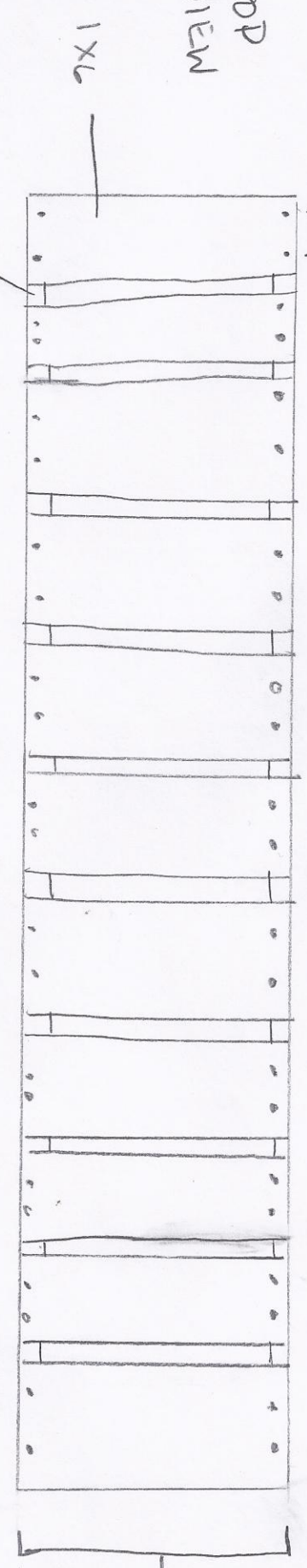

RIDGWAY PUMP TRACK: SKILLS LADDER

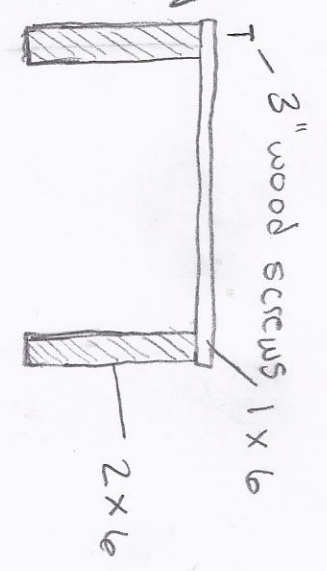
SIDE VIEW

The meeting convened at 5:35 PM

- I. Approval of Minutes from August 27, 2012

- II. Discussion of New Youth Bike Trial in the Dennis Weaver Memorial Park – Rick Weaver

Jen shared the history and origin of the trail and how it was building, including flagging and re-flagging the trail location and Brian's work with the local youth community corps to construct the trail.

Rick expressed the following concerns he and Rusty have with the existing trail:

- *The south access from the parking lot off of RiverSage Drive needs relocated to originate from the primary trail access at the entry east of the parking area, directly accessing RiverSage Drive*
- *The overall size of the trail is larger than expected (they thought it was only going to be on the "flat" area, not up the hillside to the west)-*
- *There is a sharp turn as the southern portion of the trail to the west of the parking area*
- *The visibility of the trail from the road.*
- *The trail should be one way (clockwise) to eliminate any conflict*

Sara and Brian have both used the trail with kids on bikes and feel the trail is safe and a good trail for youth. Sara expressed it may not be for all levels of youth, but both do not feel the trail as laid out is too much for the users.

Brian agreed to relocate the southern trail access point, but only if the trail remains in its current location otherwise.

Jen will meet with Rusty to share the outcome of the discussion and see if he has further concerns.

Rick suggests calling this latest trail "Eagle View" because of the optimal viewing of the eagle memorial from the trail.

III. Update and Status on Priority Projects for 2012:

Jen submitted the list to Council and these will be reviewed as part of the budget process.

1. Dog Park Property Acquisition and Development discussion – Doug Canright and Jen Coates
-Jen and Doug are meeting with the property owner on Friday to discuss the next steps in acquiring the dog park property. \$5k is proposed for 2013 Town budget contribution for the project.

2. Presentation of ideas for developing the Volunteer Adopt a Park Program – Jennifer Mandaville
-Jennifer presented an overview of the Adopt a Park concept, referencing the plan from Nederland. This would involve designating a park or a portion or element of a park for "adoption", identifying the required tasks to be undertaken as well as the responsible parties for these tasks and coordinating this with Town staff.

General concepts for the program include: regular monitoring (once week), Town providing resources such as garbage bags, doggie bags, etc., application process for town or committee approval, training to be provided, checklist for each area of what is to be done, park assets and duties assigned (litter, clean, rake, weeding, graffiti removal, etc.), bathroom inspections.

Jennifer will meet with Danny Powers, Rusty Weaver and Joanne Fagan to discuss parks needs generally and for 2013 in particular. Jen Coates will provide a list of parks to Jennifer.

3. Signage for Dennis Weaver Memorial Park – Rick Weaver
- \$1500 is proposed in the Town's 2013 Budget for this project.

4. Pickleball Court Over-Striping out at Athletic Field – Rick Weaver
-Pickleball court has been approved by Council and Larry Gallagher and crew may over stripe the basketball court.

5. Placement of Banner Poles in Hartwell Park – Jen Coates
- Jen will be working on the Request for proposals and \$5k is currently proposed for the 2013 budget.

6. Cottonwood tree fencing in Rollans Park and adjoining Town Property at the river – Jen Coates, Jared Coburn and Doug Canright

7. Contract status update for CU-Denver and design/construction of stage in Hartwell Park – Jen Coates and Doug Canright
- \$25,000 is required for this project. There is currently about \$12k from fundraising efforts that are available as a contribution, the remainder will need to be identified.
8. Sara and Paula (Transition Our Way) are working with Adam Johnson to have students build bike racks at the school. The "artistic" bike racks program still needs to be worked on.
