

Resolution No. 10-05

Resolution of the Ridgway Town Council, State of Colorado,
Adopting Outdoor Watering Restrictions

Whereas, the Town's Comprehensive Plan and Strategic Plan reference the desire to encourage water conservation;

Whereas, watering restrictions which limit the time of day and the frequency of watering assist in the efficient use of water;

Whereas, the majority of respondents to the 2009 community survey support the implementation of mandatory outdoor water restrictions;

Now, therefore be it resolved the Town Council of the Town of Ridgway, Colorado, does hereby adopt the following voluntary outdoor watering restrictions which shall apply each year between May 15th and October 15th:

1. Properties located on the south side of HWY 62 (and south side of Hunter Parkway) utilizing municipal water should only irrigate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
2. Properties located on the north side of HWY 62 (and north side of Hunter Parkway) utilizing municipal water should only irrigate on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays.
3. No irrigation should occur on Mondays, and irrigation on designated days should not occur between the hours of 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM in order to minimize evaporation.
4. These restrictions do not apply to drip systems and the use of hand-watering containers.
