

RIDGWAY TOWN COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

JANUARY 18, 2012

The Council convened for a special meeting at 4:30 pm at 201 N. Railroad Street. Members in attendance were Councillors Durnan, Hunter, Johnson, Weaver, Mayor Pro Tem Clark and Mayor Willits. Councilmember Kavanaugh were not present for the call to order.

1. Application for retail liquor store license at 177 Sherman Street, Unit 105; applicant: Gregory Doudt (continued from the meeting of 11-11-12)

The Town Attorney was present by telephone and suggested the Council enter into an executive session subject to State Statute Provisions 24-6-402(4)(b)&(c) to receive legal advice on specific legal questions and matters subject to the attorney/client privilege.

ACTION:

Councillor Johnson moved to go into closed session, Councillor Durnan seconded and it carried unanimously.

The Council entered into closed session at 4:30 p.m. with the Town Manager and Town Clerk.

The Council reconvened to open session at 5:20 p.m.

Mayor Willits explained the Council will deliberate and render a decision with findings of fact for the application, noting Council will consider the testimony given in the public hearing at the previous meeting.

The Town Attorney explained to the Council the findings would need to be based upon the desires of the adult inhabitants of the neighborhood and the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood.

Councillor Kavanaugh entered the meeting at 5:30 p.m.

There was discussion by the Council and questions addressed to the Town Attorney.

ACTION:

Mayor Pro Tem Clark moved the desires of the adult inhabitants and reasonable requirements have been met for the application of retail liquor store license for Gregory Doudt and the license is approved. Councillor Johnson seconded and the motion carried with Councillors Durnan, Hunter, Johnson, Weaver and Mayor Pro Tem Clark voting yes and Councillor Kavanaugh voting no.

The Council instructed the Town Attorney to prepare a record of finding of Council review and approval.

The meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
